The Board of Directors ("Board") of the Evans Fire Protection District ("District"), Weld County, Colorado, held a regular meeting and public hearing at Evans Fire Station 2, 2100 37th Street, Evans, Colorado 80620, on Monday, August 28, 2023 at the hour of 6:30 p.m. concerning a proposed Supplemental 2023 Budget.

Also present was District legal counsel, Michelle Ferguson.

President Achziger reported that, prior to the meeting and public hearing, each Director was notified of the date, time, and place of the meeting and the purpose for which it was called. She further reported that a Notice of the public hearing on the proposed Supplemental 2023 Budget was published in the Greeley Tribune on Saturday, August 26, 2023. Notice of the public hearing also was duly posted. Thereupon, Director Thereupon, Director Introduced and moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

#### **RESOLUTION 2023-05**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET REGARDING THE APPROPRIATION OF MONEYS TO AND THE EXPENDITURE OF MONEYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND; TRANSFER OF MONEYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE CAPITAL FUND; AND THE EXPENDITURE OF MONEYS FROM THE CAPITAL FUND FOR THE EVANS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY 2023 AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER 2023.

WHEREAS, the Board, after complying with notice and other statutory requirements, duly adopted a budget for fiscal year 2023;

WHEREAS, after adopting the 2023 budget and making appropriations thereunder,

- The District received a donation of \$15,000 from PDC Energy for necessary items related to response at energy sites. The District deems it necessary to purchase additional items to meet this need, requiring an expenditure of \$2,000 from Small Tools, an expenditure of \$3,800 from Water Supply, and an expenditure of \$9,200 from Respiratory Protection.
- Due to rising costs, the District has recognized the need for additional expenditure in Station Utilities of \$6,000.
- Due to ongoing issues, the District has recognized the need for additional expenditure in Legal Services of \$10,000.
- The District realized storm damage to the roof of Station 2 and subsequently filed an insurance claim, resulting in the receipt of \$143,658 in insurance funds for necessary repairs.

An appropriation of \$143,658 to the Capital Fund is necessary for the additional expenditure of \$143,658 in Capital Station Maintenance.

• The District has determined the need for major repairs to Engine 2 requiring an additional expenditure of \$25,000 in Capital Apparatus Maintenance.

WHEREAS, the District Board authorized administrative staff to prepare and submit a proposed Supplemental 2023 Budget reflecting the additional appropriations to and expenditures from the Capital Fund and additional expenditures from the General Fund, as set forth above;

WHEREAS, a proposed Supplemental 2023 Budget has been submitted to the District Board for its consideration. A copy of the Supplemental 2023 Budget is attached to this Record of Proceedings;

WHEREAS, due and proper notice, published and posted in accordance with the law, advised the public that (1) the proposed Supplemental 2023 Budget was available for inspection by the public at a designated public office; (2) a public hearing would be held on Monday, August 28, 2023; and (3) interested electors could comment on or file or register objections to the proposed Supplemental 2023 Budget any time before the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on Monday, August 28, 2023, and interested electors were given the opportunity to comment on, or file or register any objections to, the attached proposed Supplemental 2023 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EVANS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO:

- Section 1. **Equipment Maintenance** Expenditure of Moneys from the General Fund. The Board hereby authorizes and approves additional expenditures in 2023 of \$2,000 from Small Tools, \$3,800 from Water Supply, and \$9,200 from Respiratory Protection for items related to energy site protection. Additionally, the Board approves additional expenditures in 2023 of \$6,000 from Utilities and \$10,000 from Legal Services.
- Section 2. **Station Maintenance** Appropriation to and Expenditure of Moneys from the Capital Fund. The Board hereby authorizes and approves an additional appropriation to and expenditure from the Capital Fund in 2023 of \$143,657.23 for completion of Station Maintenance.
- Section 3. Purposes of Supplemental 2023 Budget Could Not Have Been Reasonably Foreseen. At the time the Board adopted the 2023 Budget in the fall of 2022, it could not have reasonably foreseen the expenses set forth in Sections 1 and 2 above.
- Section 4. **Adoption of Supplemental Budget for 2023.** The Board hereby adopts the Supplemental 2022 Budget in the form attached to this Record of Proceedings.
