

**RESOLUTION
BOARD OF DIRECTORS
EVANS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
SUPPORTING FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICTS IMPOSING IMPACT FEES**

WHEREAS, new development and building places a tremendous burden on Colorado's fire protection districts, both financially and in providing their life-saving emergency services, including fire suppression, fire prevention, hazardous materials, rescue and emergency medical services. Worse, it is left to a fire protection district's existing taxpayers to pay the financial price tag, instead of the cost being borne by the new development or building; and,

WHEREAS, authorizing fire protection districts to impose a reasonable, one-time fee on new development or building will help fire protection districts to meet the financial and service burdens created by new development and building, and will avoid unfairly requiring existing taxpayers to pay for new development and building.

NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned organization or governing body adopts this Resolution in support of the legislation being sponsored by Representative Tim Dore, which authorizes Colorado's fire protection districts to lessen the burden of new development and building within their jurisdictions by imposing reasonable impact.


